The TDA Tele-Radio Station is a paid TDA internship opportunity for our outgoing TDA 2021 Form 5 students. The internship will teach students how to develop radio and TV media production skills, as well as skills in distribution platforms and the technology used to produce, edit and broadcast content. The TDA Tele-Radio interns will learn how to:

build a media studio; create and produce TV and radio content; run a live radio station and podcast; film the happenings of TDA and the surrounding community; interview TDA staff and influential leaders in the surrounding community. **The goal of the TDA**

This paid internship will run from 1 February to 31 July 2022, and will be a great career introduction into the media, and other fields.

The 2022 TDA Tele-Radio Interns will continue this media tradition and run a live Tele-Radio Station that will broadcast on YouTube and other platforms from TDA's campus. How Will it Work?

The **TDA Tele-Radio Station** will be led by Mr. Ian P. Venganai, CEO of Ian P. Universal (PTY) LTD. TDA is accepting 3 interns for this programme, who will work a full work week under the guidance of Ian P. Universal and The TDA Tele-Radio Team. The Tele-Radio Station will be a professional radio and TV station. The team will, among many things:

- ★ Work in conjunction with the current TDA Tele-Radio talent and learn all aspects of Tele-Radio operations
- ★ Work towards setting up a 24 hour online radio station
- ★ Conceptualize their own programs
- ★ Appear live on digital radio and TV as hosts and presenters

The content creation will be driven by what is happening in and around the The Dow Academy campuses, Mochudi, Botswana and the wider world. The team will be creating content around TDA, Botswana, international affairs, sports and personal stories. The interns will be interviewing, recording, filming and reporting on issues of interest to the community.



Starting January 2021, TDA started to invest in the purchase of all the Tele-Radio equipment because we believe in equipping TDA students with real world commercially viable life skills. TDA has therefore been purchasing state of the art media tools and equipment for the TDA Tele-Radio Station, as well as paying an internship allowance to afford the interns an opportunity to create world-class content. TDA will continue making this investment as we understand the power of media and digital skills in today's world.

How Do Students Apply?

All interested 2021 Form 5 Graduates from The Dow Academy are eligible to apply. Students should fill the internship application form by clicking <u>here</u> and selecting the Tele-Radio internship. Parents should fill the consent form by clicking <u>here</u> to confirm consent for their child to participate.

The deadline for the student application and parent consent form is **Monday 22 November 2021** and will be strictly enforced.

How Will Students be Accepted in the Programme?

After the **Monday 22 November 2021** deadline, all applications will be reviewed and 10 students will be invited for an in-person interview. This interview will take place on **Friday 26 November 2021** at the TDA Tele-Radio Station location at The Dow Academy Primary School Campus. From this interview, 5 students will be selected to take part in practical trial exercises to take place from **24 January 2022 to 31 January 2022**.





Based on these practical trial exercises, we will select the final 3 interns who will serve as interns, with the internship starting on <u>1 February 2022</u> and ending on <u>31 July</u> <u>2022</u>. **#CourageCreativityCommunity #ReDiteemance**
