How Will it Work?

The programme is open to <u>10 TDA and</u> <u>NON-TDA Secondary School Form 1 to</u> <u>Form 4 students</u>. The programme will run two times a week, every Tuesday and Thursday from 14:00 to 15:30.

The Tele-Radio Station will be a professional radio and TV station.



The team will:

- ★ Set up a professional state-of-the-art media studio (click here to learn how a studio is built)
- ★ Run a live radio station (click here to learn how a radio station works)
- ★ Produce video content (click here to learn how a TV station works)

The content creation will be driven by what is happening in and around the The Dow

Academy campuses, Mochudi, Botswana and the wider world. The team will help create content around TDA, Botswana, international affairs, sports and personal stories. The interns will interview, record, film and report on issues of interest to the community.
